<p>Credit system</p>	<p>PURPAN follows the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).</p> <p>Workload of a full-time PURPAN student = 30 ECTS per semester, which is 60 ECTS per academic year.</p> <p>Specificities for an exchange student:</p> <p>“Ingénieur” program: this curriculum including not only courses, but also internships and reports not always accessible to exchange students, their course load cannot correspond to 30 ECTS per semester. Exchange students can usually choose courses worth between 15 to 25 ECTS per semester in the “Ingénieur” program. They should thus inquire about their Home Institution requirements, and check how they can reach them with this programme.</p> <p>EURAMA program: 30 ECTS for Semester 1 only (= Fall Semester)</p> <p>IBC program: 26 ECTS of classes for Fall Semester</p> <p>SSAP: 9 ECTS for classes + 3 ECTS for Internship = 12 ECTS</p>

General grading system	<p>PURPAN follows the ECTS grading scale. Local examinations are graded out of 20, and are translated into ECTS grades as described hereunder.</p> <p>The pass mark for exchange students is 10/20, unless specified otherwise. Some courses may indeed be validated with ECTS, based on attendance (with the mention “Pass”). Compensation may be offered according to the compensation rules applicable to each course or according to general results of the student.</p>

Linguistic knowledge	<p>“Ingénieur”:</p> <p>The language of tuition is French.</p> <p>Students need to have a level B1 in French at least (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). However, a level B2 is recommended.</p> <p>We will offer 30 hours of French as a Foreign Language when students arrive at PURPAN; but the aim is not to reach a CEFRL level (like the B2 recommended), it's more to help students adapt to the change of language of tuition (oral + written) and eventually detect improvements to be made.</p> <p>EURAMA:</p> <p>The language of tuition is English.</p> <p>In order to study in good conditions, we require a minimum level of English: TOEFL iBT: 80 (with speaking 20 min.) / IELTS: 6 (with speaking 6.0).</p> <p>IBC:</p> <p>The language of tuition is English.</p> <p>We ask students to have a level B1 in English at least (according to the CEFRL: Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*). However, a level B2 is recommended to study in good conditions.</p> <p>We will offer 20 hours of French as a Foreign Language classes (“survival French”, at levels A1-A2) at the beginning of each Semester.</p> <p>In addition, students can also sign up for French courses within the "Université Fédérale de Toulouse" (50 € / module). Please contact Delphine SEGUI for more information.</p>

<p>Insurances</p>	<p><u>Compulsory by French law:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Medical & Hospitalisation <u>For European students:</u> Copy of the European Health Insurance Card or an international insurance for the whole period of studies. <u>For Non-European students:</u> - <i>For non-EU students staying < to 3 months:</i> International Private Insurance for the whole period of studies; - <i>For non-EU students staying > 3 months:</i> you must sign on (& pay) for the basic French student Social Security (217€ for 2017/2018 academic year). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Personal Civil Liability (also called “third-party damage”). It covers students for body injuries and for material damage caused to a third person. <p>Ecole d'Ingénieurs de PURPAN will register students to its insurance center MSA (Mutualité Sociale Agricole) for Work Accident: for internships & everyday travel from accommodation to school; for this purpose, they must provide us with a copy of their original birth certificate + its translation into French by an official translator.</p> <p>PURPAN also asks medical and funeral Repatriation coverage to the home country.</p>
